Kakuyasu Group were certified as Excellent Corporations for Health Management 2022

Kakuyasu Group Co.,Ltd (Headquartered in Kita-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director and President Junichi Sato; hereinafter Kakuyasu Group), its subsidiary, Kakuyasu Co.,Ltd. (Headquartered in Kitaku, Tokyo; Representative Director and President Junichi Sato; hereinafter Kakuyasu) announce that they have been recognized as Certified Excellent Corporations for Health Management (large enterprise category) by the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry and the Nippon Kenko Kaigi. Kasuyasu Group has been certified for the third consecutive year. Kakuyasu, which was established in October 2020, has been certified for the second consecutive year.

The Certified Excellent Corporations for Health Management Recognition Program honors largescale and small- and medium-scale companies that are conducting excellent health management based on the initiatives for regional health problems and the health promotion initiatives noted by Nippon Kenko Kaigi. By increasing the visibility of companies that engage in good health management, the scheme aims to develop an environment in which companies can be positively assessed by other members of society, including employees, job seekers, related companies, and financial institutions as companies that consider employee health management from a business management perspective and are engaged in strategic efforts for improving it.
